

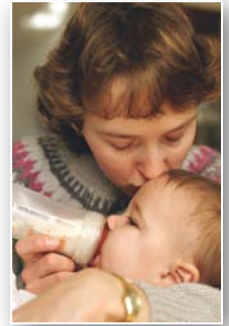
Your Appeal Dollar Supports

21,600 people received emergency assistance with food, medications, utility payments, shelter, and other basic necessities

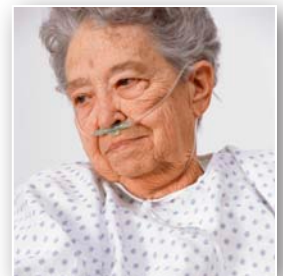
1,846 parents and children received material assistance, information, and case management services through the First Step program
